Dr. Konstantin Aravossis is a Mechanical Engineer (Technical University of Aachen - Germany) with an M.Sc. in Management Science from Imperial College - University of London. He has further been awarded a PhD by the National Technical University of Athens, focusing on Operations Research.

He is an Assistant Professor of "Planning, Management and Assessment of Technological and Environmental Investments at the NTUA (National Technical University of Athens) and a Professor at the ATHENS MBA (NTUA - Athens University of Economics) since 1997. He is the Coordinator of the "Environmental Economics and Sustainable Development Research Group" of the Sector of Industrial Management and Operations Research of the Mechanical Engineering School. He has been an adjunct Professor at the University of Thessaly (1997-2004).

He is the President of the Ordinary Environmental Committee of the Technical Chamber of Greece (member since 2005) and Vice President of the Coordinating Committee of the Institute of Production and Operations Management / Hellenic Management Association. He is a member of the Democracy Institute "K. Karamanlis", at the Sector of Economy and Development.

He is the General Secretary of the NTUA Employers' Support Fund (since 2009), a member of the Environmental and the NTUA scientific Publishing Senate committees and has been a member of the NTUA Senate (2008-2009).
